## **Activities**

In order to build the characters of the youngsters the Sevashram constructed and administers to shrines with prayer halls – one each at Parbakshi & Deulgram, inside which the photographs of Bhagaban Sri Ramakrishna, the holy mother Sarada and Swami Vivekananda are seated on the altar. People from all walks of life are allowed to perform daily prayers and meditation here. The halls are sometimes used to conduct study circle for the students of various schools of the locality. This is highly benefiting the people of the locality and countless numbers of men and women have taken this advantage to become better citizens of the country.

The Sevashram runs a boys' hostel at Deulgram and it can accommodate 30 boys. At present, there are 12 inmates. There is a well-managed. There is a computer room and a library.

The Sevashram joined hands with the governmental authorities in their efforts to bring about betterment of human living conditions. With a view to so doing the Sevashram, in the year 2014, imparted training to 30 trainees each on two wheeler repairing, wool-knitting and tailoring in association with the National Small Industries Corporation (NISC), Govt. of India and 36 women in total from different self-help groups sponsored by Govt. of West Bengal in 2015 and 2016. It constructed a total number of 341 green toilets in different villages of Bagnan-I Block in Howrah district under the Nirmal Bangla Mission in 2014, 2014 and 2016. The Sevashram offered its own land to the Department of Youth and Sports, Govt. of West Bengal to build a mini sports complex at Deulgram. Many people of the locality take drinking water from its deep tube well.
